Know Before You Go

Camping Reservations Required

To create a safer, family-friendly environment, all camping at Lake McConaughy and Lake Ogallala State Recreation Areas (SRAs) requires an advanced reservation for arrival dates beginning May 20. This includes all campgrounds and beach camping areas at the two SRAs.

Know Before You Go!

Advanced camping reservations will be required for stays May 20 through September 10. There are three easy ways to make a camping reservation:

- Online at **NebraskaStateParks.ReserveAmerica.com**.
- Download the 'RA Camping' app available on iOS and Android via the App Store or Google Play.
- Call the park office during business hours: 308-284-8800.

Reservation Window:

- For designated campsites in campgrounds, visitors may reserve 180 days prior to arrival date.
- For non-designated beach campsites in camping areas, visitors may reserve 30 days prior to arrival date.
- **All campers should reserve an overnight campsite before leaving home.**
- Same day reservations may be made at any of the methods above until 5:00pm, if campsites are available.

Upon Arrival:

Campers with a valid reservation must check in with park staff, in-person, at the Visitor Center or a staffed entrance booth between 2 p.m. and 9 p.m. Mountain Time.
