Official Rules of the Youth Outdoors Nebraska Jr. Fishing Tournament
PARK PERMITS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL VEHICLES THAT ARE ON GAME & PARKS GROUNDS

RULES MEETING ON FRIDAY, JUNE 16, AT 6:00 P.M.
Keith County Fairgrounds Exhibit Hall – 1100 West 3rd, Ogallala
Please attend meeting for rule changes.

REGISTRATION: Check in for registration is required for all entrants as numbers will be issued at that time. Tournament officials will be available from 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Saturday, at Van's Lakeview. Everyone **MUST** leave from Van's Lakeview. Fishing will be permitted on Lake McConaughy only. Fishing from a boat is not required, all teams must check in before fishing. Teams must be at Van's Lakeview to be inspected. Youth Outdoors Nebraska will be available to help load & unload boats at Van's Lakeview. Each team must keep fish separate if more than one team is fishing together. **NO SPECTATORS IN THE BOAT.**

TEAM FORMAT: TEAMS WILL BE ONE ADULT AND ONE CHILD. LIMIT OF TWO TEAMS PER BOAT.

CHILD: 15 years of age on June 17, 2023, and under. ADULT: age 16 and over.

ENTRY INCLUDES: Friday evening meal at 6:00 p.m. at Keith County Fairgrounds Exhibit Hall, 1100 West 3rd Street. Guests and non-contestants may eat for an additional fee on Friday evening.

FISHING LAWS: All Nebraska State Fishing Regulations and daily limits will be complied with.

TOURNAMENT LIMITS: Only five (5) fish per species per team at weigh-in.

TOURNAMENT FISHING HOURS: Saturday, June 17th, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

CHECK-IN: Weigh-in starts at 3:00 p.m. at Van's Lakeview. Entrants **MUST** be in line by 3:00 p.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Awards will be given for total pounds of the following five species: Walleye, Wiper/White Bass, Northern Pike, Smallmouth Bass and Catfish. There will be trophies awarded for the largest fish in each species. **Every child will win a prize – please do not leave early.**

TOURNAMENT DECISIONS: All decisions by tournament officials will be final.

All proceeds of the tournament will be used by the Youth Outdoors Nebraska for youth activities.

Entries postmarked on or before June 1st, 2023, will be entered into a drawing for a \$75 prize pack, drawn at the rules meeting.
